

Become a Radio Announcer

You have been invited to do a “3 minute spot” on your local radio station. Your topic is to promote a book that you have read.

1. Create the talk you will give to promote your book.
Begin by webbing your ideas—think of the key events, characters, setting, and message in a fiction text, or the ideas, view point, and message in a non-fiction text.
2. You may want to talk about the author so you may need to do a little research. Jot a few key points on the BLM that you think are important to mention.
3. Refer to your webbed ideas and identify what you enjoyed about this book.
4. You might jot down other books on a similar topic or by the same author that your listeners might also enjoy.
5. Practise your talk before sharing it with your classmates.

Tip: If you're introducing a chapter book, you might hint at the exciting parts but without giving all the details. If your book is non-fiction, you might describe some of the photographs or illustrations, suggesting a specific one that the readers might find captivating.


